In math, students will model a double and doubles plus 1 in addition problems and identify corresponding addition equations. Compare and contrast 3 Dimensional shapes based on attributes. Count on to subtract. Identify 2 and 3 D shapes in real world objects. Understand missing addends. Make a ten to subtract. Compare and contrast shapes into different categories. fact I know.

First Grade: In science, students will learn "The Montessori five Great Lessons" the stories will be introduced in a dramatic storytelling experience. The first lesson is the formation of the solar system. The next lesson is about the formation of Earth, and how life began. After that, students learn how humans roamed the planet. From there, we get into the story of language, both written and verbal, which is also when our history began. And finally, we tell the story of numbers and how the many numeration systems that existed throughout time have influenced our lives today.
