Our Lessons



In Reading, the students will be reading a chapter book called *How Not to Start Third Grade*. They will also be working on reviewing different areas of grammar and literacy devices such as understanding character traits and theme.

In Writing, the students will be working on developing an expository essay.

In Social Studies, the students will be learning about the classroom rules and regulations. The students will also be learning citizen traits such as: tolerance, compassion, fairness, acceptance, dependability, etc. Our focus will be to ensure that we have a working classroom community.
