In Reading, the third graders will be working on Comparing points of view. The second graders will be looking at many characters and many points of view. They will be learning how to identify different perspectives within the stories they read. They will also continue to practice their inferences, vocabulary in context, and figurative language.

In Writing, the students will be practicing the structure of a fictional narrative. They will also learn about the different types of fiction. When revising they also will look for opportunities to add similes and imagery-based details.

In Mathematics, the second-grade students will continue to work with two-digit numbers. They will be working with one and two-step word problems, as well as, begin working with three-digit numbers. The third graders will be working on multi-digit word problems with one to two steps.

In Science the second grade students will be focusing on plant parts and their functions. They will also be working on learning how day and night work and changes in states of matter. The third graders will be working on star formation, and different types of forces.

In Social Studies, the students will be learning will be exploring the major Native tribes of Florida in celebration of National Native American Heritage Day. The third grade students will also be exploring natural y physical landmarks in North America.
